#### **COMMANDERS COMMENTS**

The recent PACT ACT, the most important and all inclusive Veterans legislation passed in 30 years is being revealed. The significant successful efforts to help Veterans & their families is inspiring.

#### MAJOR LEGISLATIVE INITIATIVES

1. The new proposed 72 bed, Chippewa Veterans Home long-term care facility with a possible assisted living & memory care unit is making its way through the Wisconsin legislature & United States Congress.

This proposed bill, Leinenkugel Hall, will be difficult to oppose with the expected \$2,300,000 sale of state property. Senate bill 205, Act 105 in the 2003 Legislative Session declared that net proceeds of any property sold at Northern Center must be used on that State property by either Wisconsin Departments of Corrections. Social Services (DHS) or Veterans Affairs.

A private firm has offered to build this facility for free, with lease/option to buy. This was done with the Stanley Prison 20 years ago.

Congressman Derek Van Orden & staff are leading the federal 2/3rds funding charge.

State Senator Jesse James, with Representatives Karen Hurd & Rob Summerfield are masterminding the 1/3 state commitment.

- **2.** US Hwy 8 is the proposed mid East Conflict Highway recognizing the Persian Gulf, Afghanistan, Iraq Veterans with the Global War on Terror.
- **3.** The Chippewa Valley Veterans Tribute could be Wisconsin's significant Site #16. The proposed plans being revealed will make this both a destination & ever improving and growing attraction for visitors both nation & world wide. Make copies of enclosed petition, get signatures and send to all WI politicians.

#### **CONGRATULATIONS!**



- 3) Wisconsin Significant Veteran Site #16, the Chippewa Valley Veterans Tribute is requested to be included in the Wisconsin State Statutes.
- 4) Proposed also in Wisconsin State Statutes is U.S. Highway 8 to be the Mideast Conflict Highway honoring Persian Gulf, Afghanistan and Iraqi Veterans and their loved ones and recognizing the Global War on Terrorism.
